Message to Guides and Scouts

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Scouting,

With this letter I am personally addressing all guides and scouts with a special message for you.

Since the beginnings of Scouting in 1907, many generations of young people have held on to and participated in the Scouting idea. Over many decades, we have been able to observe how young people have become responsible adults who are self-critical and always ready to take on their tasks in society.

Each generation of Guides and Scouts has its own specific challenges, and the so-called modern times have changed the way we interact with each other as people, both locally and globally. Distances between continents can now be bridged almost 'just in time' thanks to modern media channels, and meetings and gatherings are easily organised virtually with video telephony and internet connections.

Thanks to modern media, we have the opportunity to communicate with each other almost simultaneously. With all these opportunities, we have been able to grow continuously as the World Federation of Independent Scouts and spread around the world.

But where there is light, there is also shadow. We all know the challenges that modern media present to us all.
